

# Rules for the selection of the World Championship FCI IHT-3 TS CACITR « Bergers de Beauce » 2026 in Ammerswil.

Eligible to participate are: 2 dogs per country + 1 dog for the organising country + 1 winner of the last FCI TS Beauceron World Championship 2024.

The following requirements are necessary for selection:

- The handler must be a citizen or resident of the represented country and be a member of the breed club of the represented country (with current membership fee) prior to the selection process (at least three months).
- The pedigree of the dog must be registered in the studbook of the represented country and have qualified at a show.

Selection will take place between 1 January and 1 December 2025 as follows:

1st	2nd	3rd	4nd	5nd	6nd	7nd	8nd	9nd
10pts	8pts	7pts	6pts	5pts	4pts	3pts	2pts	1pt

Example: 1st + 2nd + 3rd = 10 points + 7 points + 8 points = 25 points.

The 3 best FCI IHT-3 TS placings with CACITR or CACTR (under at least two judges) will be considered.

Handlers must submit their application with their results and proof of membership of their FCI-recognised national club to the committee (troupeulagorce@gmail.com) by 1 January 2026 at the latest in order for it to be approved by the Organising Committee.

Please note: Only results validated by the FCI will be considered! In the event of a tie, the dog with the most competitions will take precedence.

If a dog is unable to participate due to injury, death or other reasons, the next dog selected will take its place.

The Swiss regulations apply.
